

2022 LDC 主題: 蛻變與突破 (Transformation and Breakthrough)

【前言】：「基督是我們的生命」是基督徒信仰的核心。一切救恩的真理、經歷、與見證都離不開這個核心的真理。從客觀來說，在我們藉著聖靈重生得救的那一刻，我們便領受了耶穌基督的生命成為我們的生命。然而，從主觀的經歷與見證來說，我們一生之久都需要持續地經歷這生命不住地成長與蛻變，不僅使基督成形在我們心裏，進而藉著「萬事互相效力」，將我們模成神兒子的形像。更因著基督的替代，讓那在瓦器裡的寶貝，在我們一切的困境中顯出祂莫大的能力，不僅帶領我們經歷突破，更是能「充充足足地成就一切超過我們所求所想的」。這是神在我們身上所要做成的，也是我們一生都需要經歷的。

第一堂：持續的生命蛻變

一. 不再蛻變，必然帶來生命的停滯

我們的屬靈生命很容易就落於停滯不前，不再成長，更遑論「蛻變」與「突破」，以致於我們的屬靈經歷常常落入各種的限制、綑綁、與困境之中。

二. 成為新造是經歷蛻變的根基

- 若有人在基督裏，他就是新造的人，舊事已過，都變成新的了。(林後 5:17)
- 4 基督是我們的生命...5 所以，要治死你們在地上的肢體...8 ...要棄絕這一切的事...9 ...因你們已經脫去舊人和舊人的行為， 10 穿上了新人。這新人在知識上漸漸更新，正如造他主的形像。(西 3:4-10)

三. 持續的蛻變是神的呼召與命定

1) 藉著「萬事互相效力」

- 28 我們曉得萬事都互相效力，叫愛神的人得益處，就是按祂旨意被召的人。29 因為祂預先所知道的人，就預先定下效法祂兒子的模樣，使祂兒子在許多弟兄中作長子。30 預先所定下的人又召他們來；所召來的人又稱他們為義；所稱為義的人又叫他們得榮耀。(羅 8:28-30)
- 凡稱為我名下的人，是我為自己的榮耀創造的，是我所做成，所造作的(賽 43:7)

2) 藉著「連於內住的基督」

我是葡萄樹，你們是枝子。常在我裏面的，我也常在他裏面，這人就多結果子；因為離了我，你們就不能做甚麼。(約 15:5)

四. 「活出基督」是蛻變持續發生的明証

- 20 照著我所切慕、所盼望的，沒有一事叫我羞愧。只要凡事放膽，無論是生是死，總叫基督在我身上照常顯大。21 因我活著就是基督...(腓 1:20-21a)

- 17 主就是那靈；主的靈在哪裏，那裏就得以自由。 18 我們眾人既然敞著臉得以看見主的榮光，好像從鏡子裏返照，就變成主的形狀，榮上加榮，如同從主的靈變成的。(林後 3:17-18)
- 我已經與基督同釘十字架，現在活著的不再是我，乃是基督在我裏面活著... (加 2:20a)

2022 LDC Theme: Transformation and Breakthrough

[Foreword]: “Christ is our Life” , is the core of the Christian faith. Every truth pertaining to salvation, every experience, and every testimony cannot be separated from this core truth. Objectively, from the moment we were born again through the Spirit, we have received the life of Jesus Christ to be our life. Yet subjectively, from personal experiences and testimonies, we shall continuously experience growth and transformation of this Life - Not only is Christ formed in our hearts but we are also conformed to the image of the Son of God. Moreover, because of the substitution of Christ, the treasure in the jar of clay shows the surpassing power of God, which not only enables us to experience the breakthrough but also does far more abundantly than what we ask or think. This is what God wants to accomplish, and what we need to experience all our lives.

Message 1: Continuous Life Transformation

1. Stop being transformed must bring stagnation in life

Our spiritual lives can be easily stuck and not moving forward or changed, nevertheless being “transformed” or having a “breakthrough” , hence our spiritual experiences often fall into various limitations, boundages, and difficulties.

2. Becoming a New Creation is the foundation of every experience of transformation

- ¹⁷ Therefore, if anyone *is* in Christ, *he is* a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new. (2 Cor 5:17)
- ⁴ When Christ *who is* our life appears, then you also will appear with Him in glory. ⁵ Therefore put to death your members which are on the earth: fornication, uncleanness, passion, evil desire, and covetousness, which is idolatry. ⁶ Because of these things the wrath of God is coming upon the sons of disobedience, ⁷ in which you yourselves once walked when you lived in them. ⁸ But now you yourselves are to put off all these: anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, filthy language out of your mouth. ⁹ Do not lie to one another, since you have put off the old man with his deeds, ¹⁰ and have put on the new *man* who is renewed in knowledge according to the image of Him who created him, (2 Cor 5:17)

3. The continuous transformation is God' s calling and destiny

1) through "all things working together"

- ²⁸ And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to *His* purpose. ²⁹ For whom He foreknew, He also predestined *to be* conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren. ³⁰ Moreover whom He predestined, these He also called; whom He called, these He also justified; and whom He justified, these He also glorified. (Rom 8:28-30)
- Everyone who is called by My name, whom I have created for My glory; I have formed him, yes, I have made him." (Isa 43:7)

2) through "abiding in the indwelling Christ"

- ⁵ "I am the vine, you *are* the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing. (John 15:5)

4. "Living out Christ" is the evidence of continual transformation

- **(Phil 3:20-21a)**
- ¹⁷ Now the Lord is the Spirit; and where the Spirit of the Lord *is*, there *is* liberty. ¹⁸ But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as by the Spirit of the Lord. (2 Cor 3:17-18)
- ²⁰ I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; (Gal 2:20a)
